

New Bible Class each Tuesday night at 7:00pm Begins on September 2 for 8 weeks

Listening to Scripture by *Richard L. Rohrbaugh* introduces six skills or strategies that will enable learners to uncover enough about the text that they can begin to understand the meaning it might have had for its first readers and hearers. Learning what the text meant is the study's first objective. From there, participants explore what the text means—the message it has for us as Christians today. 8 Sessions.

The skills taught will be:
Exploring the Historical Setting
Discovering the Literary Context and Audience
Identifying Oral and Literary forms
Analyzing the Structure
Investigating Words and Phrases
Putting it all together.

This class will be taught by Rev Susanne Havlick who was ordained in 1996. Her Masters in Divinity is from Lutheran School of Theology in Chicago. Susanne's previous career was teaching Journalism at Harper College in Palatine. She retired as a full professor to take her first call at Lutheran Church of the Resurrection in Oak Forest, Illinois. She served as interim pastor at Lutheran Church of the King now Abounding Grace in Tucson for four years. Currently she is in a joint ministry with Rev. Stewart McDonald at Wilcox. Besides being a pastor she has written devotions for Christ in Our Home.
