

Advocacy Ministries Fueling Justice in Arizona and Nevada

How congregational giving lifts faithful voices in our state legislatures

Every dollar given in **mission support** by congregations across the **Grand Canyon Synod** fuels ministry that transforms lives and strengthens communities. This impact extends beyond our sanctuaries into statehouses, neighborhoods, and public spaces. Through Lutheran Advocacy Ministry in Arizona (LAMA) and Lutheran Engagement and Advocacy in Nevada (LEAN), your generosity lifts voices of faith and action, working toward a more just and compassionate world.

Mission Support is the portion of a congregation's financial gifts that is shared with the Grand Canyon Synod and ELCA Churchwide ministries. These contributions connect people, proclaim the Gospel, and create new possibilities for ministry throughout our synod and beyond. Advocacy ministries like LAMA and LEAN are a living witness to what it means to be church together, in public life and service.

This year, **LAMA** reached a historic milestone by hosting its largest-ever Arizona Lutheran Day at the Legislature. More than 200 Lutherans and partners participated, representing 29 of Arizona's **30 legislative districts**. This was a 60% increase from the previous year. Attendees engaged in advocacy training, a Capitol tour, and scheduled meetings with 45 legislators. They raised faith-grounded support for key policies such as **HB2213** (Free School Lunches). That bill continues to move through appropriations, and legislators like Rep. Nancy Gutierrez and Sen. Analise Ortiz are now proactively reaching out to the LAMA network for input and partnership.

In Nevada, **Lutheran Engagement and Advocacy in Nevada (LEAN)**, led by their new Director **Rev. Paul Larson**, held the Nevada Lutheran Lobby Day. Over 20 participants

from seven ELCA congregations and one Episcopal church met with lawmakers in six separate meetings. **They advocated on more than 70 bills related to housing, immigration, food insecurity, and care for creation.** Your mission support fuels this growing advocacy presence and builds bridges between Northern and Southern Nevada.

A \$3,500 synod grant, made possible through mission support, allowed LAMA to purchase

essential bill-tracking software. This investment significantly increased the ministry's capacity to monitor and respond to more than 1,800 bills introduced in the Arizona legislature this year.

Through the **Grand Canyon Synod Hunger Leaders Network** and events such as the 40-40-40 Lenten Challenge, congregations are directly engaging in advocacy for food justice, water conservation, and equity.

These ministries thrive because of your congregation's faithfulness. When your church gives mission support, you create space for public witness, for community engagement, and for justice to flow like an ever-flowing stream.

Whether it is a free school lunch for a hungry child, an emerging advocate learning to speak in the public square, or a leader discovering how faith shapes their civic responsibility, **your congregation's mission support makes these moments possible.** Thank you for living into our calling as church together.
