During the 2019 ELCA Churchwide Assembly, the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America declared itself a sanctuary church body. Sanctuary: What does it mean? In its simplest form, becoming a sanctuary denomination means that the ELCA is **publicly declaring** that walking alongside immigrants and refugees is a matter of faith. The ELCA Churchwide Assembly—the highest legislative authority of the ELCA—is declaring that when we preach on Sunday that Jesus told us to welcome our neighbor, we will use our hands and voices on Monday to make sure it happens.

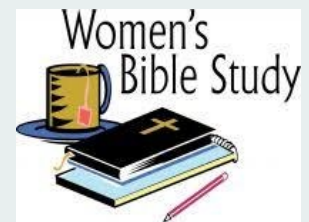
